All Star Kids Club Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Action Plan

This Action Plan has been created with guidance from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Texas Department of Health and Human Services and the “Open Texas Checklist for Child Care Operations” following Executive Order GA-23 issued by Governor Abbott on May 18, 2020. This plan is subject to change, with the issuance of new orders or guidance provided by the Governor of Texas, the President of the United States, or any other applicable authority.

This plan will address the following considerations:

- Implementing social distancing strategies
- Modifying drop off and pick up procedures
- Implementing screening procedures upon arrival (and throughout the day)
- Intensifying cleaning and disinfection efforts

Social Distancing Strategies

The State agrees that some of the protective measures that we can expect from adults, such as wearing cloth face coverings and maintaining distance from one another, are, for a variety of reasons, simply not possible for children and youth in schools. In some cases, the child will be too young to understand and practice these precautions. All Star Kids Club will be practicing the following social distancing strategies:

- To the extent possible, classrooms will include the same group each day with only the instructors and assistant instructors present.
- Group activities will be altered or halted until further notice:
 - Bathroom breaks will be staggered
 - No group gatherings such as in pictures or in choreography
 - Students will not be allowed to congregate in the halls or near the bathrooms

Parent Drop-Off and Pick-Up

The drop-off and pick-up of children will be completed outside the back of the building, unless it is determined that there is a legitimate need for the parent to enter. Should the parent have a legitimate need to enter the operation, the parent must be screened (temperature check).

- A hand hygiene station (hand sanitizer with at least 90% alcohol) will be set up at the entrance. However, we will ask students to wash their hands before entering class.
- Students will not be allowed to bring outside items into the studio. Please remind your child that backpacks, notebooks, toys, and other materials should stay at home.
- Students can be collected after class using the same entrance at the back of the building within 15 minutes after class is over.



Screening

The following individuals must be screened every day before entering the facility:

- All Star Kids Club staff;
- Persons with legal authority to enter, including law enforcement officers
- Children enrolled at All Star Kids Club; and
- Parents who have children enrolled at the All Star Kids Club.

Parents should only enter the studio when absolutely necessary and will be required to wear a mask to enter.

Staff and students will be screened prior to entering the facility. Any staff member or child who has any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19 will be sent home.

- Cough
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Muscle pain
- Known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-189
- Headache

As has always been All Star Kids Club's policy, children and staff **must be fever free for 24 hours, without the use of fever reducing medication**, prior to returning. Given the current circumstances, additional symptoms and return dates will be determined on a case by case basis, following CDC guidelines. **Please keep your child home if they show any sign of illness.**

Personal Protection Equipment (PPE)

- Children 2 years old and younger **will not be allowed** to use masks or facial coverings due to the risk of asphyxiation. Over the age of two, usage of a facial covering is at the discretion of the parent/guardian.
- Classroom teachers are required to wear masks while in the classroom with only their children and required to wear a mask when in the presence of other adults when 6 feet distancing is not possible.
- Custodial staff must wear a facial covering while cleaning rooms occupied by children and or staff. It is recommended that custodial staff wear facial coverings at all times.
- All Star Kids Club staff and volunteers must wear a facial covering when accessing a space used in All Star Theatre Studios.



Cleaning and Disinfecting

The All Star Kids Club will be intensifying our cleaning and disinfection efforts. At this time the All Star Kids Club will have staff members onsite from 8:30AM-5:30PM to assist classroom teachers with routine cleaning and disinfecting. The facility will then be cleaned again each evening once children and staff are no longer present, between the hour before the next camp starts.

- Handwashing sinks will have signs posted for proper handwashing.
- Surfaces and objects that are frequently touched will be routinely clean, sanitized, and disinfected. In addition to toys, table tops, and chairs; this also includes doorknobs, light switches, sink handles, nap mats, and cubbies.
- Restrooms will be cleaned and disinfected three times per day.
- All cleaning materials will be kept out of reach of children.
- No bottle waters, or snack bags will be allowed. We will provide water and desposable cups for student use.
- We will not allow snacks or lunches. Please send your child already fed a hearty meal.

Note from the State:

“The virus that causes COVID-19 can be spread to others by infected persons who have few or no symptoms. Even if an infected person is only mildly ill, the people they spread it to may become seriously ill or even die, especially if that person is 65 or older with pre-existing health conditions that place them at higher risk. Because of the hidden nature of this threat, everyone should rigorously follow the practices specified in these protocols, all of which facilitate a safe and measured reopening of Texas. The virus that causes COVID-19 is still circulating in our communities. We should continue to observe practices that protect everyone, including those who are most vulnerable.”

“Please note, public health guidance cannot anticipate every unique situation. Schools should stay informed and take additional actions based on common sense and wise judgment that will protect health and support economic revitalization. Schools should also be mindful of federal and state employment and disability laws, workplace safety standards, and accessibility standards to address the needs of both workers and customers. Federal and state regulations regarding schools should be followed.”
